

Declarative vs. Non-declarative


Declarative:

- Available to conscious retrieval
- Can be declared (propositional/implicit)
- Examples:
 - "What did I have for breakfast?"
 - "What is the capital of Spain"

- Non-declarative
 - Experience-induced change in behaviour
 - Cannot be declared (procedural/implicit)
 - Examples
 - How to ride a bike
 - Subliminal influence

Episodic memory

- Memory for personally experienced events that occurred in particular place at a specific time (Tulving, 1972)
- Contextual, spatiotemporal, autobiographical remembering
- Hippocampus
 - Famous case of patient HM
 - Memento

Semantic memory

- Memory for facts, general knowledge, word meanings
- Acontextual
 - Independent of where and when the information was encoded

Working memory

The ability to hold information "online" for current task (Baddeley, 1992)





Serial position






A change in speed, accuracy or bias of processing a stimulus owing to prior exposure to that stimulus

Procedural Memory

- Skill learning
- Requires multiple trials



Mirror Tracing (e.g. Corkin, 1968)

Classical conditioning

- Changes in response to conditional stimulus after repeated conditioned – unconditioned stimulus pairing
 - Forward
 - Simultaneous
 - Backward
 - conditional response tends to be inhibitoryň

Latent inhibition – CS is presented at first without US
Inhibited response to learning



- Short term memory is limited to ~7 items but long term memory is unlimited
- Special cases
 - Hyperthymesia
 - Superior autobiographical memory
 - Eidetic memory
 - Photographic memory
 - Mnemonists
 - Savants
